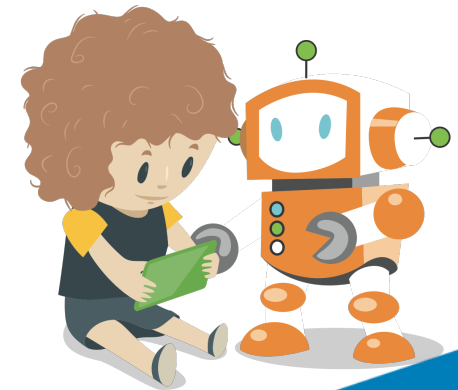

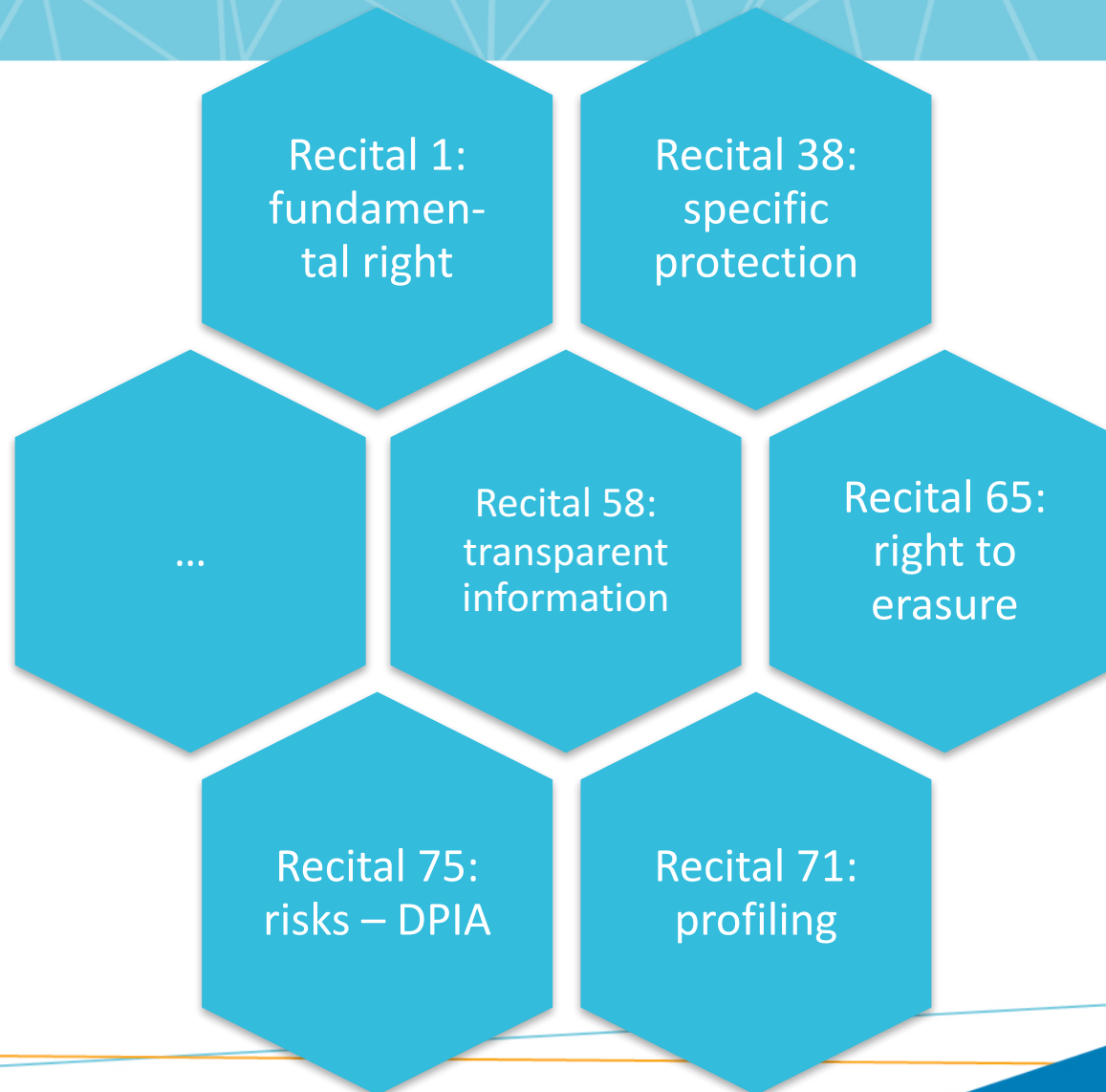
Article 8: Conditions applicable to child's consent in relation to information society services

1. Where point (a) of Article 6(1) applies, in relation to the offer of information society services directly to a child, the processing of the personal data of a child shall be lawful where the child is at least **16** years old. Where the child is below the age of 16 years, such processing shall be lawful only if and to the extent that **consent** is given or authorised by the holder of **parental responsibility** over the child.

Member States may provide by law for a lower age for those purposes provided that such lower age is not below **13** years.

2. The **controller** shall make **reasonable efforts** to verify in such cases that consent is given or authorised by the holder of parental responsibility over the child, taking into consideration **available technology**.

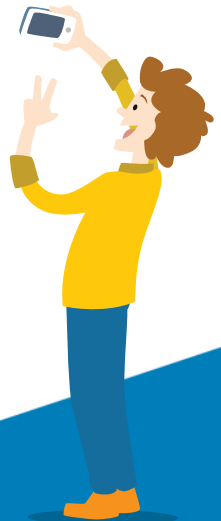

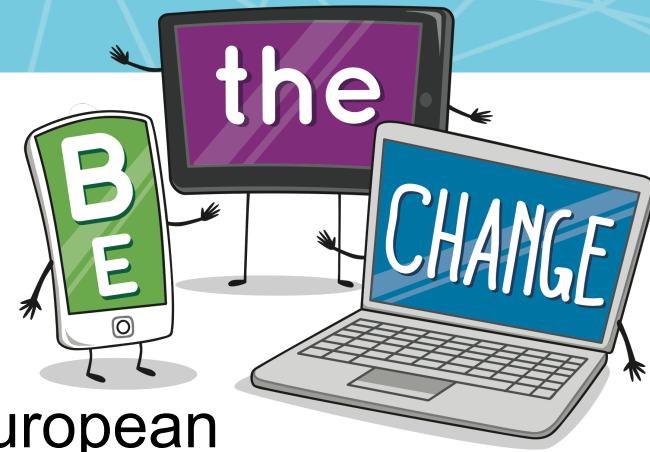
